Now is a good time to review if you need to make golf club orders, so that you are prepared for the 2023 season. I recommend getting new wedges every 2-3 years, a new driver every 3-5 years or so, new irons (with fairway metals or hybrids) every 4-7 years, and a new putter when you're not feeling too hot about your putting game! So, if you're beyond some of those timeframes listed above, check out any of the top brands websites, find the specific items you want, then email the link to me at mmorrow@7cedars.com. This is a great way to spend some of your book money and get more positive results from your game. These are just recommendations and it does depend on player ability along with number of rounds played per year so your specific timeframes may vary a bit.
