During the score posting season, our local rule #8 explains "winter rules".

Preferred lies/Winter rules: When "winter rules" are in effect, a ball in the general area may be lifted, cleaned, and replaced without penalty. The ball must be marked prior to being lifted and must be replaced on its original spot. A ball lying in a closely mown area [fairway] may be placed within one club length of the spot from which it was lifted no nearer the hole. Once it is placed, it is in play.
