The then 23-year-old then raised the issue with tournament rules officials, reviewed the footage and was assessed a two-shot penalty for his error. Why wasn't he DQ'd for signing an incorrect scorecard you ask? You'll find your answer under Rule 3.3b3, which allowed him to be retroactively penalised for unknowingly violating a rule.
