Our Spring season is off to a strong start! FYI - PGC's 2nd biggest event of the year, the Spring Shotgun, will be happening in May, so get your 2-person team in as soon as possible - more details below!

### Here is a review of our last month's activities:

- The BIG CUP tournament was held on Saturday, 4/15/23. Mike Dupuis & Tony Walker were our big winners in the 1st flight (gross & net respectively) and Steven Davis and Nic Harrison were our big winners in the 2nd flight (gross & net respectively). Mike Dupuis shot the overall low gross with a 58!
- Our first Spring/Summer league day teed it up on 4/19/23 and 4/23/23. We have 20 teams and more than 200 players signed up! If your team has a couple openings, do what you can to fill them up. If you have any roster changes, let us know as the deadline will be 4/30/23 for any changes. It'll be a great year for our league with friendly competition and time spent hanging out at PGC.
- The Men's Club 2-Man Scramble occurred on 4/24/23 - shout out to the groups of Casey Northern & Tony Walker and Mark Mast & Dave Wahlsten for their gross and net victories in that event!
- The High School match season is starting to wind down as they only have about one more month left of play. Our boys and girls teams have only lost one time each - well done! They're playing great and they're our next generation of players here!

### Upcoming events:

- a. We have a Coast Guard event on Friday, 4/28/23, 9am start - they are expecting 40-50 players. We can accommodate golfers that day, but we ask that you work with the pro shop on your tee times.
- b. We also have the Wilder Baseball Fundraiser tournament this Saturday, 4/29/23 with a 10am shotgun. The course is *closed most of the day* as they have well over 100 players, so please plan accordingly and discuss with the pro shop if you usually play that day.

2. As mentioned above, we are taking sign-ups for the 2023 Spring Shotgun which will take place on Saturday & Sunday, 5/27/23-5/28/23, with optional practice round on Friday, 5/26/23. We will send a couple more reminder emails to work to get a full-field for the event. Please review that and the form and get your team together! Payment is due at the time you get your team submitted. Many sign ups are starting to roll in and right now most of our sign-ups are from people out of town. Members – please sign up soon to get your names in the mix.

2. Horse Races begin on 5/5/23. These events are every other Friday at 5:30pm and 2-person teams, alternate shot format. Signups must be in at 1pm on the days we play.

3. The Men's Club 2-Man Chapman is scheduled for 5/21/23. Get a teammate and be here that Sunday morning.

4. We have a Taylor Made demo day here on 5/31/23 from 11am-4pm - appointments only. If you're interested in trying some clubs at the range, let the pro shop know and we will put your name on the sign-up sheet.

5. Please remember to log into your USGA GHIN app and review your contact information. Most of our results and updates are sent via email, so it's important that you have that information there and it is accurate. Please remember to post your scores, even if you play 9 holes. We are also available if you have any questions about this.
