1. The Wilder Baseball Fundraiser tournament is this Saturday, 4/27/24 with a 10am shotgun. We can accommodate some of our other golfers, just plan ahead with the pro shop for that day.
2. As mentioned above, we are taking sign-ups for the 2024 Spring Shotgun which will take place on Saturday & Sunday, 5/25/24-5/26/24, with optional practice round on Friday, 5/24/24. We will send a couple more reminder emails to work to get a full-field for the event. Get your team together! Payment is due at the time you get your team submitted.
3. Horse Races begin on 5/3/24. These events are every other Friday at 5:30pm and 2-person teams, alternate shot format. Signups must be in at 1pm on the days we play.
4. The Men's Club 2-Man Chapman is scheduled for Sunday, 5/19/24. Get a teammate and be here to sign up that Sunday morning.
5. We have a Taylor Made demo day here on 6/1/24 from 12pm-4pm - appointments only. If you're interested in trying some clubs at the range, let the pro shop know and we will get you signed up online or get you the link.
6. We have an outside group playing 5/4/24 (CED tournament) We can accommodate our members and some additional play on that day, just talk to the pro shop & plan ahead.
7. If you are in merchants league, look for more communication soon on match play and other fun happenings! Remember, if you play in league and have a handicap, you must post your 9 hole scores to your GHIN.

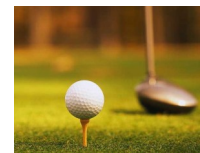
