Here is a review of our last month's activities:

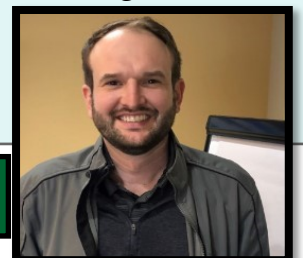

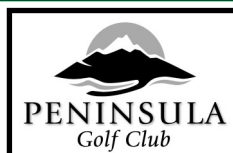
