### Here is a review from last month:

+ The 2025 PGC Golf Calendar is now posted on the website (under the "Events" tab) and copies will be posted at various locations around the Club. Copies will be emailed out also. The calendar is prepared in full to help you formulate your 2025 Golf Gameplan!

+ We completed our first event of the year, the New Year's Shootout, on 1/18/25. We had 56 players and it was an excellent competition. Congrats to Mark Mitrovich & Sid Krumpe as well as Jered Pomeroy & Brian Boone for their gross and net victories respectively.

### Ongoing events:

+ We're in the final weeks of our Fall/Winter Merchants' League. Currently the Dream Team, Har Bar, J. Power Painting, Hoch Construction, and team N-Dub are in 1<sup>st</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> with just 5 weeks to go. We're still averaging over 75 players per week for the League - really impressive turnouts! We'll see who wins the final segment, regular season & playoff championships! We'll also see how much each team gets in prize money and who will be the big winners of the raffles at the end of the season at the league banquet, which will be 3/5/25 @ The Clubhouse.

+ We've had 30 people sign up so far for the 2025 Driving Range Program. The program allows participants up to 1 & ½ buckets per day to their liking. Many of them get their moneys worth in the first few months. Note: we have a special going on for Certificate Members through 2/15/25 on the range program, just talk to us if you're interested! We also have a range punch card option for some savings.

### Upcoming events:

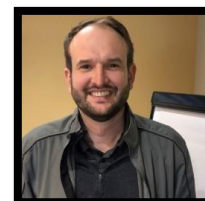

February events:

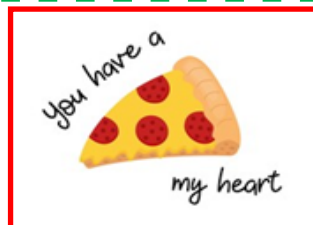
Saturday February 15th - Coast Guard Breakfast - majority of the dining room will be full from 8:30 - 10:00 am.
