Here is a review since our last newsletter:

+ The 3 Golf Club & Par 3 Challenge took place on 2/22/25 and we had 26 players. Congrats to Jered Pomeroy, Troy Tamas, & Jacob Lippold for their 1st place finishes as well as Craig Dawe for his 1st place finish (gross & net respectively). Shout out to Jered Pomeroy for hitting a hole-in-one on #9. That is a rare feat and is even more rare to have that happen during a tournament.

+ Winter Merchant League continues and will end on 3/3/25. 11 teams are competing for their final positions. The top 4 teams will move onto the League Playoffs, which will start the week of 3/10/25. The banquet for the league is planned for Wednesday, 3/5/24 at 4:45pm. Please let us know if you plan on going!

+ We will have a 3-person "Blarney Scramble", coming up on Saturday, 3/8/25. This will be a 9:30am shotgun. We've averaged about 50 players the last 2 years. Join in on the fun. It's \$50 for members and \$80 for non-members. If your full team signs & pays up before or on 3/1/25, we will give each player \$10 off.

+ From Friday 3/21/25 through Sunday 3/23/25, youth golfers from all over Washington will be competing in the WA Junior Golf Association (WJGA) Match Play Championship at PGC. There will be 128 youth golfers at the course. This is a nice honor for us to host this event and I will be sending out a specific email about the details in the next few days. For now, please note that *Friday (3/21/25), the course will close starting at 12pm. On Saturday, the course is closed for the event all day. On Sunday, the course reopens for regular play around 1:30pm. Note: The Cedars @ Dungeness will host and comp any PGC members greens fees that want to play there on Saturday, 3/22/25. Reminders and more information will be sent on this one-time event.*

+ The PA High School teams will start practicing and playing at PGC on Monday, 3/3/25. So if you're looking to practice and play golf in the afternoon, just know that the 3-5pm hour will be busy through mid May. Only 2 range spots are open from 3:30-4:30 due to practice also. We wish the teams well and good luck for their upcoming golf season!

+ USGA posting season is almost here! Washington golfers begin posting on 3/1/25. Be sure you log into your USGA account and click "My Profile" to make sure your contact information is accurate.
