Upcoming events:

- ◆ The Spring/Summer Merchant League will begin on Wednesday, 4/16/25. Please review the guidelines for this year and get your team in! We just received our first couple team entry forms. When you sign up, be sure to check your emails for tee times and the league-specific calendar.
- ◆ We will have a BIG CUP tournament on Saturday, 4/12/25. This event is just tee times from 9:10am to ~10:15am. If you're interested, talk to a pro shop team member and we will put your name down and we will keep everyone informed of the details. Players that sign up & PAY by 4/4/25 get a \$5 discount.
- ◆ If you're interested in a our series of (4) rounds from now until July, centered around the golf majors, talk to a pro shop team member about our "PLAY the MAJORS" series which will start the weekend of 4/3/25, a week prior to the Masters.
- ◆ We have a couple outside groups coming for tournaments this month and in early May: Friday, 4/18/25 Longshoreman (~50 players, led by Al Osterberg); Tuesday, 4/22/25 the Coast Guard Scramble (~50 players), Saturday, 5/3/25 the course will be closed for about 1/2 the day for Wilder Baseball tournament fundraiser (~100 players); Tuesday, 5/6/25 Duke Streeter (~50 high school players, a mid-day start).
